Compensation and Privileges

In appreciation of your efforts, you will receive the following:

1. Hotel accommodations (50% paid) for two nights (Friday and Saturday) if you judge for the two day event
2. Free transportation between the airport, hotel and tournament site.
3. Free admission to the Master's Demonstration
4. Free admission to all events
5. Free lunch for Saturday and Sunday if you judge for the two day event.
6. Judge's shirt, ID tag, and information packet
7. Recognition in the tournament program brochure

Meetings

Attendance to the Judges' meetings is mandatory, at the following days and times:

1. Friday, 8:00 pm at the hotel
2. Saturday, 8:00 am at the tournament site

Events and meetings will start on time. Please be punctual.

Competition Formality

Performance and appearance of judges are crucial to the quality of the event. To maintain high standards, we need your cooperation in following the guidelines below:

1. Attend all meetings in a punctual manner and arrive at least 15 minutes early
2. Always wear proper attire as follows:
 - a. Judge's shirt (provided)
 - b. Long, dark-colored pants (black preferred)
 - c. Shoes
 - d. No hats for sunglasses
 - e. No clothing that covers the judges' shirt
3. Perform professionally as a judge by:
 - a. Following the format and rules of the competition
 - b. Paying full attention to the performers in your ring
 - c. Handling complaints rationally, according to the rules and regulations
 - d. Ensuring the competition begins on time in your ring
4. We appreciate your availability (if necessary) to fill in with other parts of the tournament, such as ring coordination and other administrative assignments.
